
DISCOUNT CARDS FOR FLORIDA ATTRACTIONS

HEALTH: GOUT AND YOUR DIET

Are you one of many individuals who suffer from gout? If so, you really need to know anything and everything you can learn regarding this disorder.

Gout is an inherited condition in which there are excessive levels of uric acid found in the blood produced by abnormal purine metabolism and inability of the kidneys to excrete this substance. Excessive amounts of uric acid that cannot be eliminated normally can precipitate out to the joints to form sharp salt crystels

In acute attacks of gout, it is believed that these insoluble salt deposits may serve to mechanically irritate joint tissues thereby producing sudden, intermittent episodes of excruciating joint pain, swelling, and inflammation. Attacks of gout usually subside after a few days only to recur several months later. Thanks to effective drug therapy, this is rather unusual today.

At one time gout was referred to as the "rich man"s disease" and was thought to be caused by excessive eating and drinking of rich foods and alcoholic beverages. This theory is now questionable.

There are, however, some general dietary recommendations currently in order to persons afflicted with gout. While fats, proteins, and carbohydrates are essential for a balanced diet, excessive fats should be avoided since they can prevent the excretion of uric acid. Protein intake should also be decreased although not avoided.

During acute attacks, purine intake should be severely restricted. Foods to be avoided or taken in minimal quantities, since they contain high amounts of purines, include meat gravies, broths, organ meats, anchovies, mackerel, herring, sardines, scallops, mussels, and sweetbreads. Plenty of fluids should be taken to aid in the elimination of uric acid.

In many instances, persons with gout are overweight.
Rapid weight-loss diets are a no-no, since this only
creates a metabolic state similar to that of a high-fat
