REPORT OF THE BY-LAWS COMMITTEE

At the January monthly meeting of the POA, Eva Hawkins, By-Laws Chairperson, described the major changes proposed by the Committee which will hopefully be brought to the membership for approval at the APRIL 15, 1992 meeting.

The major thrust is aimed at enlarging the size of the Board of Directors from nine (9) to thirteen (13) and to having the membership directly elect the President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer. This would change the current method of electing members to the Board and having the Board select the officers from among their nine (9) members. Under the proposed change, the new, elected officers would automatically become both the officers of the Association and of the Board for their terms of office.

It is also proposed that the President and Vice-President be allowed to run for a second consecutive term for their respective offices and that the Secretary and Treasurer could serve, if re-elected each year up to three (3) years.

It is suggested that the Nominating Committee be allowed to nominate not more than two (2) candidates per office instead of

retaining the current mandate whereby that Committee must select only one (1) candidate for each opening. This is being done in order to give the Nominating Committee more lee-way should the members determine that more than one equally qualified POA member is interested in running for a specific office.

This partial report was brought before the membership before the Board voted its acceptance or disapproval so that members of the Board would have the opportunity to receive imput from the membership before making its decision.



GOLF CART CROSSING HIGHWAY 27/441

Bob Johnson, Lady Lake, had an excellent article in the "Daily Commercial" on January 22, 1992. Some excerpts of this article, for safety reasons; "What moves across U.S. Highway 27 the fastest?

- 1. People walking?
- 2. Cushman carts?
- 3. Golf course lawn equipment such as mowers?
- 4. People riding battery operated three-wheel carts because they cannot walk at all?
- The answer is a golf cart. As fast as the cushman and twice as fast as the others mentioned. All of the above are being done today except for the golf carts." A bridge or tunnel, over or under the highway is good idea but cost prohibitive. Would this be cost effective? Should general taxes be used to construct same? It appears we have some opposition from other Lake County residents.

We in OBG do have some rights as citizens who also pay taxes to support our common interests. We deserve crossing rights the same as other Florida communities.

Petitions signed by OBG residents have been submitted to Town Manager John Lynch of Lady Lake not only requesting support of the golf cart crossing but also reducing the speed limit to 45

miles per hour for safety. At the present rate of 55 miles per hour it is not even safe for automobile crossing the highway for any reason as the number of accidents at the intersections indicate. The speed limit needs to be reduced!!!!

Mayor Lee Hokr and Town Manager
John Lynch met with DOT State
official Gil Hooley on Thursday,
January 23, 1992 to support a
pedestrian crossing with push buttons for walking. (Walk and Do
Not Walk Signals) Support to lower
the speed limit to 45 miles per
hour is necessary to expedite a
safe walk crossing.

To promote this and the golf cart crossing, Mayor Hokr and Town Manager Lynch are traveling to Tallahassee for February 12th and 13th to acquire the help of Ben Watts a State official and to attend the League of Cities Conference.

RECREATIONAL FACILITIES

Inquiries were made from members as to what has happened in our approach to management for additional recreation facilities due to the impact of new people buying homes here, as well as maintenance of the present facilities. The Board will make another request for information. Justification of increased golfing fees was also requested. What additional costs were incurred???
