SPECIAL NOTICE

At the April 15th meeting only members who have paid their 1992 dues may attend. This meeting is primarily for the adoption of new by-laws. You must have your membership card with you in order to be admitted.

This special meeting is necessary in order to change the by-laws to allow the membership to elect the officers of the POA. Under the current by-laws, officers were elected by the Board of Directors from the Board's members. This is the major change.

DELIVERY OF MAIL IN THE VILLAGES

At the March 18th POA meeting, eightyseven year old Henry Kaiser spoke both with eloquence and humor about the current mail delivery system in the Villages and the need for a change.

Some of the residents are unable to pick up their mail at a postal pickup station and have to rely on neighbors; many of the rest of us see ourselves in the same situation as we get older and driving becomes a chore if not impossible.

The logical answer to the problem is home, curbside delivery of the mail throughout the Villages, and the POA is willing to put forth an all-out effort toward this end if we receive a clear mandate that you want this change to be made. Our neighbors in Spruce Creek, a fairly new retirement community, enjoy curbside delivery, so we know there are no federal regulations which would prohibit such delivery in OBG.

Our problem revolves around an April, 1985 agreement between OBG management and the U.S. Postal Service that OBG would build postal stations and the Postal Service would furnish mailboxes and pay rural carriers to deliver and sort the mail. Over the years, since then, the U.S. Postal Service has resisted change, basing its decision on the 1985 agreement.

In 1988, before the new facility was built on Paradise Drive, groups of residents protested at a Town Commission meeting; and Vice-President Gary Morse was quoted in the newspaper as saying: "We'd love to have door-to-door delivery. We can't get it."

In the Fall of 1990, with Gary Morse expressing the same sentiments he had in 1988, the POA conducted a survey in its monthly Bulletin to determine the extent of dissatisfaction. Because only about 600 hundred (600) replies were received, no further action was taken.

At its March 18th meeting, the POA decided to circulate a petition to determine how many of our residents throughout the Villages want home curbside delivery of mail. The POA, since its inception in 1975, has been the residents' voice, sometimes loud, sometimes considered abrasive but always persistent in promoting that which is seen by residents as their right and in their best interests. The POA will not proceed in negotiations with the U.S. Postal Service. however, unless there is a clear mandate from you, the residents, to do so.

You can expect to see, within the next few weeks, volunteers with petitions at all of the postal delivery stations on both sides of Highway 27/441 and at other sites within the Gardens. The number of signatures received will determine whether or not action will be taken.

REMINDER FOR RESIDENTS WHO HAD SENIOR CABLEVISION AND NOW HAVE LAKE CABLEVISION
