The calling card was a social necessity in the 18th, 19th and early 20th centuries.

They were used for formal and social visits, serving to introduce people, foster acquaintances and encourage courtships.

When calling on friends and neighbors who were not home, a card was left on a tray in the entrance hall

The cards were folded in various ways to let the people know the occasion for the visit.

If the upper right corner was folded, it was a personal call. When the upper left corner was folded, the visit was for congratulations.

A folded lower right corner meant an adieu. Condolences were being given if the lower left corner was folded.

Finally, if the entire left side of the card was folded, it signified a call on the entire family.



# REPORT ON FEBRUARY 27TH V.C.C.D.D. MEETING

I am listing below the questions I asked and the answers I received.

Q. Why was the matter of moving the Post Office removed from the agenda of the meeting of the Lady Lake Commission?

A. It will be back on the agenda soon.

Q. Why has there been no discussion of removal of the trail fee for the executive golf courses?

A. There has been no reason to bring it up.

(My response: that's what they think about us.)

A vote was taken on the 4-hour parking limit on C.D.D. property. All voted in favor of it.

No parking for any bus (for trips) unless permission is given by the property owners. Only one bus service so far has done this - - The Villages Travel Co.

You residents got what you deserve on this one. You did not stand up for your rights.

One resident attending the meeting complained about having to go to Spruce Creek for bus pick up to go to the Strawberry Festival in Plant City; and said it was a damn shame for the Villages to stoop so low as to permit NO OUTSIDE BUSSES on "their" premises.

So residents will have to suffer the inconvenience if you or your club would like to go on a bus trip. You will have to use the Village Travel Co. bus or suffer the consequences.

REPORT ON THE MEETING OF CD.D. #1 (continued in next column) Regarding lighting problems in Sumter County, three extra street lights and lights for signs to entrances will be installed.

Monies will be taken out of the surplus in the budget. Installation and maintenance will be picked up by all lot owners.

### REMINDER TO SUMTER COUNTY RESIDENTS OF C.D.D. #1

For the first time, you will have the opportunity to vote for two (2) members of the Board of Supervisors in November without the developer casting any votes!

More importantly, two residents have the opportunity to be candidates for election to the Board.

They have until noon on July 17th to file the necessary papers to qualify as a candidate:

- 1) a statement of candidacy.
- 2) a financial disclosure form, and
- 3) the signatures of 87 or more qualified electors of the district on a petition.

They also need to execute the loyalty oath and have a campaign treasurer and bank account.

Those who do not wish to stand for election could offer their support to a district resident they feel would represent the best interests of all district residents.

The female may change her mind at any time. The male must never change his mind without the express written consent of the female.


The female has every right to be angry or upset at any time. The male must remain calm at all times unless the female wants him to be angry and/or upset.




